The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/6/92.)

The 2nd Special Survey No.1, due 9,40 was partly held in October last.

No.1 hold tank side brackets (p + s) require to be shipped & coated

The Yokohama Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, the Special Survey advanced, repairs to framing, tank top in fore and after peaks and minor repairs effected.

Renewals are recommended to after peak and fore peak tank tops at the completion of the Survey and in addition a considerable part of the Survey remains to be carried out.

The Owners propose to advance the Survey in September next.

They do not desire a fresh record of survey.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without fresh record of survey as recommended, subject to renewals as recommended.
