I am very conscious of the fact that the rapid increase in the work in Germany has added to your difficulties of keeping up to date with reports and correspondence, but I should esteem it a favour if you would give priority to my letter of the 21st ultimo regarding the steamers "ALPHA" and "RHEINLAND".

You will see therefrom that we have been trying to get a reply from you since August, and as I understand you have now been successful in getting additional help, I look forward to a reply as soon as possible.

I feel I must also draw attention to the Return 5b. which, for November, is very lengthy, and would suggest that you make a concerted effort to get rid of the very old cases before the December Return has to be sent in.
