Having, in accordance with your instructions, examined the Masts, Spars, Iron Work of same, and Rigging, of the

I have to report that I found Foremast and Topmast in good condition.

FORE RIGGING - Port side No. 1 and 2 shroud corroding badly, recommend renewal.

Starboard side No. 1 shroud corroding badly, recommend renewal.

" " No. 2 " recommend cleaning and reserving.

MAIN MAST RIGGING - Port side No. 1 and 2 shrouds recommend cleaning and reserving.

Starboard side No. 1 and 2 same as above.

MAIN TOPMAST - badly shaking, recommend renewal.

MAINMAST - in good condition.

All Screws and Shackles recommend annealing and oiling.
