Dear Sirs,

With reference to correspondence which took place between us in March last, respecting the steamer "RALDO", I beg to acquaint you that according to a return received from the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle-on-Tyne dated the 13th April last the vessel was then under survey at that port for damage but the report of this inspection has not yet come to hand. It is concluded however, that the inspection of the lower bunkers in completion of the General Examination commenced in August last has now been carried out.

A further complete General Examination will require to be held by the end of August next, together with a survey for the renewal of the Load Line Certificate, which also expires at that time, and unless the requirements of these inspections are now receiving attention I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know your proposals in this respect in due course.

I take this opportunity to add that the Boiler Survey also becomes due at the end of August next.
