S. I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Genoa, respecting your steamer "SAN PIETRO", and having submitted the same for the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting to-day, I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
