Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you I am in receipt of a letter from the Society's Surveyors at Genoa from which it appears they have been informed by the Owners of the steamer "SAN PIETRO" that this vessel is at Montreal loading for either Antwerp or Rotterdam and that on her arrival at one of these ports the Special Survey N°2 will be commenced. I have therefore to request that you will give the case the necessary attention should this steamer arrive in your district.

For your information I may say that no part of the Special Survey has yet been held on the hull, the vessel will be eligible for a record of \* I.M.C. 2,27 in one tube in the port combustion chamber of the port boiler the main feed check valve of the centre boiler have been renewed; and the propeller, sternbush, sea connections, auxiliaries, pumping arrangements, condenser and steam pipe examined.

I have to add that the vessel retains class subject to the tank top in the holds being repaired

As the Annual Survey of the boilers became due so long ago as January last you will be good enough to advise me promptly should the vessel leave your district before this survey has been completed.


