The class of this vessel is subject to the tank top in the holds being repaired at the Owners' convenience, the equipment being placed in order (stream anchor to be tested or renewed, and 60 fathoms of chain cable to be examined and verified with the certificates of test) and two indented plates dealt with at a convenient opportunity, and to the riveting of butts of bottom plating and after end of garboard strakes being made good at the next dry docking.

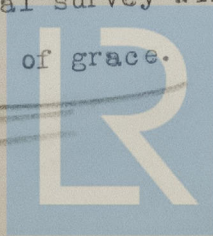
The S.S.No.2 became due 12,26.

The Rotterdam Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated, several butts of bottom plating recaulked and electrically welded, some rivets in the after garboard strakes renewed, minor repairs effected, and the rudder mainpiece repaired by electric welding where corroded.

The Surveyors recommend (that a bower anchor which has been repaired be tested at the Owners' convenience and) that the rudder mainpiece be specially examined at the next dry docking.

The tank top in holds and indented plating have not yet been dealt with or the equipment placed in order.

It is stated the special survey will be carried out before the expiration of the year of grace.
