Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have before them at their Meeting to-day a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, from which it appears you have informed them that it is not desired to maintain the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "YAMAMARU", and I am directed to say that in view of your instructions have been given for the vessel's name to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots to be inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of classification at owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby null and should be returned to this Office.
