Nature of Survey.....

The Kobe Surveyors recently reported this vessel examined in dry dock and found in a good condition, wear and tear excepted.

The same Surveyors now further report the vessel placed in dry dock, the bottom cleaned and coated.

The oil fuel settling tanks have been removed and the oil fuel connections dispensed with and side coal bunkers erected in place of the tanks at port and starboard sides of boiler space, to the Surveyors' satisfaction.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 2,27, as recommended.

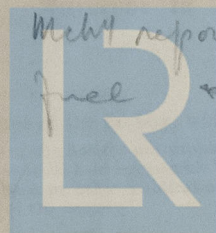
