Dear Sir, M/V "FLORIDA MARU", Kobe Report No. 4787.


In reply to your letter dated 15th. April 1925 re above vessel, I have to state that the lengths of the poop and forecastle are as given on the freeboard report, namely 27.66 feet for poop and 31.0 feet for forecastle.

The inner surface of the double bottom plating in way of the fresh water tanks only is protected with thick cement, and in the oil fuel tanks, the steel is left bare.
