The Second Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in May 1924, and action has been deferred by the Classing Committee from time to time owing to the steamer being laid up in the Zambesi River, the Owners having furnished the usual undertaking.

As the result of the decision of the General Committee in November last in regard to cases laid up under the usual undertaking, the Owners were at that time asked to submit the vessel to general examination, as unless this were done and the vessel found in good condition the Committee would be unable to allow her class to remain undisturbed any longer.

The Owners stated in reply that the vessel was in the hands of Brokers with a view to sale and asked for a further short extension of time before complying with the Committee's requirements. This was agreed to by the Classing Committee, but as it would appear that the position as regards the sale of the vessel is still unchanged and the Owners admit that there is no immediate prospect of her being submitted to Special Survey, the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 20th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been informed accordingly.
