Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to previous correspondence between us respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "WATERBUCK", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have again had the case of this vessel under consideration at their Meeting to-day.

The Committee note that there would appear to be no immediate prospect of the vessel being submitted for Second Special Survey No. 1, which is now so long overdue, and in all the circumstances, they have decided to give instructions for her class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
