Dear Sirs,

S. Reverting to your letter of the 8th June 1925 accepting the conditions under which the Committee of this Society were, at that time, agreeable to the classification of your Steamer "WATERBUCK" remaining undisturbed in the Register Book, I beg to acquaint you that the case of this vessel has again come up for consideration.

As you are aware, the Second Special Survey No. 1 became due so long ago as May, 1924, and as the vessel would appear to be still laid up, with no immediate prospect of being again placed in commission, the Committee do not see how they can agree to her class being retained in the Register Book indefinitely.

They will, however, be willing to allow the vessel's class to remain undisturbed until the next Periodical Survey (the Second Special Survey No. 2) becomes due in May next, provided a general examination be now made by the Society's Surveyors and the Steamer be found in good condition.

I may add that, if the vessel is still laid up when the next Periodical Survey becomes due in May next, it will be necessary for this inspection to be held at that time, if it is
