

H. With reference to your report N°1331 on the steamer "WATERBUCK" which has been lying up at Chinde for sometime past, I have to acquaint you that the Owners have been informed that with a view to meeting their convenience the Committee will be agreeable to the vessel being surveyed at Chinde before she is placed in commission by a Surveyor appointed by Lloyd's Agent at that port and that provided the Boiler Survey be then held and the vessel submitted to a General Examination and be found or put in an efficient condition to proceed to Durban or East London for survey the Committee will not object to her making a voyage to either of these ports in order to carry out all necessary repairs, the overdue 2nd Special Survey N°1 and the survey of the screw shaft. In the circumstances I have to acquaint you that the Committee will authorise you to carry out the inspection in question in this instance and I shall be glad if you will attend to the case accordingly should it be decided to submit the vessel to your inspection.
