Dear Sirs,

Reverting to your letter of the 3rd March last intimating that your Steamer "WATERBUCK" is still laid up inside Chinde Bar, Zambesi River, Portuguese East Africa, I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have again had the case of this vessel under consideration at their Meeting to-day.

As you are aware, the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Second Special Survey No. 1 expired at the end of last month, and in the circumstances, the Committee can only agree to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present subject to the conditions usually required by them in similar cases, viz:- that the overdue surveys and all necessary repairs be completed before the vessel is again put into commission, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and should she be offered for sale to inform intending purchasers that the vessel is allowed to remain subject to this being done.

I shall therefore be glad to learn that you are
