Dear Sirs,

H. I beg to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society have had before them a letter received from the Owners of the Motorship "SIR CHARLES ORR" in which they state that the Modified Survey of the Oil Engines of this vessel, which according to the Society's Rules became due at the end of July last, may be carried out at Nassau provided they receive one week's notice of the day on which it is proposed to take place.

In view of the fact that the Society has no Surveyor stationed in the vicinity of Nassau, the Committee have decided to ask you to be so good as to appoint a competent and independent Surveyor to hold this inspection on behalf of this Society upon your receiving a request from the Owners to do so.

For the information of the Surveyor I enclose herewith a sample report, together with an abstract from the Society's Rules setting forth the requirements of the survey in question. A form for reporting the survey is also enclosed which should be returned to this Office in due course, and I may say that all fees and expenses in connexion with the matter must be paid by the Owners and should accordingly be charged by you to them.
