This vessel, which was built in August 1930 under the Society's supervision, was classed +100A1 with freeboard. She did not appear in the 1931 Bureau Veritas, but was entered in their 1932 Register, having been surveyed by them in August 1931 and given their highest class 1 3/3 1.1. It is customary in the Bureau Veritas to make the mark  $\pm$ , denoting that the vessel was built under the supervision of another classification society, after special examination, but no such record appears in the Bureau Veritas in the case of this vessel.
