POSTPONED SURVEYS.

Case of the Iron Steamer "DAISY"

15th October, 1940.

Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your memorandum of the 19th ultimo intimating that the steamer "DAISY" is still laid up at your port.

In the circumstances the Committee have deferred further consideration of the case for the present, but in view of the fact that more than two years have elapsed since the Third Special Survey No.1 became due, and that the vessel does not appear to have been seen by one of the Society's Surveyors in drydock, since November, 1935, the Committee consider that you should make arrangements with the Owners for the vessel to be generally examined at a reasonably early date, in drydock, with a view to her condition being reported upon.

I shall be glad to learn, in due course, what arrangements the Owners are making for the requisite examination to be held.
