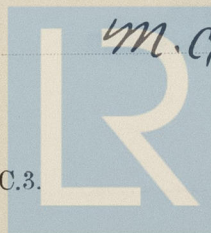
- (1) That the overdue surveys and all necessary repairs shall be completed before the vessel again proceeds to sea if she remain my/our property; and
