Whenever the replacement of Anchors or Chains is reported the particulars be clearly stated in the space provided on the back of this form. State also the dates and initials of any letters in this case.

Where cases where the Surveyor has not made a special damage report he is required to state whether he has his services for this purpose and to whom and why they were declined.
