With reference to the First Entry Report on Hull of Messrs The John Duthie Yerry S.B. Co's vessel, H.M.S. "Daisy", now almost completed, & which is expected to be forwarded to you on Monday first, I beg to state that the Builders are desirous of being furnished with the classification certificates as early as possible.

In the meantime, the First Entry Report cannot be completed, owing to the Builders having misplaced the cables, & put part of the sister vessel's cables on board the "Daisy", but same are being re-arranged to be ready for Monday.

The vessel is expected to be ready for handing over to the Admiralty Officers at the middle of next week, & the Midship Section is being forwarded herewith to facilitate the preparation of the classification certificate.
