In reply to your letter Classen (H) of 10th instant in respect of the above named ship we have to state that we know very little about this ship as she is not a classed ship and did not come under us for survey at all.

We understand that two new combustion chambers, were fitted to the damaged boiler and two doors and part renewed, stays and tubes renewed a

The ship has been back in service for some time now and we understand that she has experienced no boiler trouble.

The new combustion chambers were made in Durban by Messrs. Gilbert Hamer & Co., Ltd., who also did the boiler repairs.

We did see the damaged combustion chambers in the workshop and noticed severe cracking between rivet holes of the furnace landing - otherwise we know very little of this case.


