It is thought that the best thing to do in the special circumstances will be to issue a fresh First Entry Certificate with the present date of issue, and with the following record as date of build, viz:-

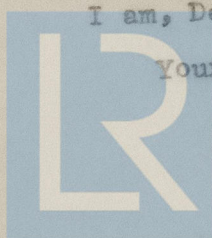
