I, Edward. S. Hunter
the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

Mr. W.W. Watson, Lloyds Agent at this port, proceed on board the
S.S. "RIO VERDE" of 679 tons, of VALPARAISO, anchored in the Punta
Arenas Roads, for the purpose of surveying the Donkey Boiler, and
found :-

2nd. May. The boiler thoroughly clean and free from
scale, the Furnace crown, uptake, shell plates, and rivets in
good condition. The cross tubes, compensating rings, and rivets
in good condition.

In view of the fact that this boiler had not
been in service since the last hydraulic test, I did not consider
it necessary to repeat it. However I requested to see the boiler
under conditions.

4th. May. I examined the Donkey Boiler under full steam
pressure of 100 lb. per square inch, at which pressure the safety valves
are set. No defects appeared.

I hereby recommend that the record be retained as in the register
book.
