Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification of the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "DAIGEN MARU", I am sorry to hear that the Committee have to-day had before them the information received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, it appears that it is not your intention to maintain classification of this vessel in the Register Book, I have to say that in view of this intimation, the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled, and should be returned either to this Office or the Society's Office at Kobe.
