

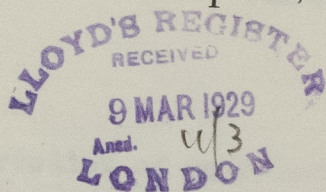

As requested in your letter of the 7th instant respecting the plan showing proposed details of cast iron scuttles for Messrs. Cammell, Laird & Co's No. 957, I beg to enclose the approved plans (three in number) for reference, together with plan showing the nature of the compartments to which the proposed scuttles give access.

The Builders point out the difficulty of fitting hinged water tight scuttles owing to the fact that cattle fittings are to be installed on the upper deck in the vicinity of the scuttles.

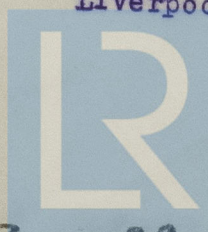
