Steamer "POLLY"

I duly received your cablegram and letter of the 25th May and have reported the case to the Committee.

They note the furnaces have been re-gauged by the Ship's Chief Engineer, but desire me to point out that it was made quite clear that, for Classification purposes, the inspection was to be held by one of the Society's Surveyors or by a Surveyor acceptable to the Committee.

In spite of every effort on the Society's part to arrange for the survey at a port suitable to the Owners it appears that they have chosen to ignore the Committee's requirements and after careful consideration of all the facts it has been decided they have no alternative but to adhere to their previous decision, i.e. to expunge the class for non-compliance with the Rules.
