Repairs: previous damages, plates told from fore.  
ss: G-2 and H-2 removed, faired and refitted.  
F-3, G-1 faired in place.  
ps: G-4, H-2 and H-3 cropped, and partly renewed.  
G-1, G-2 and G-3 removed, faired and refitted.  
The rudder head was found twisted about 10°.  
The head was transported to the work shop for inspection and control.  
The key way shifted correspondingly and quadrant refitted. Found good.
