Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 28th ultimo respecting the steamer "EMPIRE CONSEQUENCE".

Our records show that the inspection of this vessel's boilers previous to June 1946 took place at Newcastle in October 1945 as a result of which the Committee assigned a record of BS (boilers surveyed) 10,45. (235 lb.) This inspection was carried out concurrently with a General Examination of the hull and machinery for the issue of a Trading Certificate for twelve months, and although no official certificates were issued, I enclose herewith a copy of the Trading Certificate dated 30th October, 1945, issued by the Newcastle Surveyors following their general inspection of hull and machinery.
