They were not constructed under Special Survey but have now been converted to the marine type by the fitting of reversing gear, pumps, & shafting, and have been opened out examined, put in good condition and installed on board the vessel under the Supervision of the Society's Surveyors. The boiler was constructed at Aberdeen under Special Survey.
