The above named vessel is due to arrive in Antwerp approximately 21st inst. in Ballast. The vessel will be dry docked on arrival or as soon after as possible. I shall be obliged if you will arrange to have the freeboard verified.

The boiler survey, which is due in April of this year, will be put in hand, and the L.M.C. due in Janry of this year will be completed.

This vessel is due to arrive in Antwerp about the 23rd inst., and on completion of discharge the vessel will be drydocked.

The S.S.No.3, due November 1922, will then be commenced and the L.M.C. due April of this year will be put in hand and completed.

The damage to the stem and hawse pipe will also be dealt with.
