It is submitted the  
Surveyor should be informed that  
the difference in the freeboard of the  
two vessels is due to the "Rotenfels" built  
at Bremerhaven having greater under  
deck tonnage than the Braunschweig  
built at Newcastle, thereby making  
the tonnage coefficient of fineness  
larger while at the same  
time the Rotenfels has  
a shorter extent of deck  
erections
