The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.



Nature of Survey

It is submitted before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Plymouth Surveyor should be informed that it is concluded that pillars have been fitted throughout where practicable, but he should state if this is so.

The Surveyor should also be requested to state whether the deck has been plated over in way of the fore and after peak tanks and if these tanks have been tested with a head of water of eight feet as required by the Rules.
