Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the case of the Steamer "OAKLAND" has recently received consideration in connection with the survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Baltimore in June/August last.

S.

As a result of this inspection, a notation of 100A1 (Classification Contemplated), has been assigned with a Docking Date of 8,47, together with a record of "Examined 8,47" valid for twelve months pending the completion of the Special Survey for classification.

The Special Survey of the machinery has been carried out and a notation of LMC 8,47 has therefore been assigned subject to boiler feed water regulators being fitted and a spare propeller, a spare impeller shaft for main circulating pump and one feed check valve lid being supplied. A record of S 6,47 is also being inserted in the Register Book in respect of the Screwshaft Survey.
