Dear Sir, **ANSD** Trawler "WYRE LAW".

The Special Survey was due in 1,50 but a six months' extension has been granted.

Several surveys on other Trawlers of the same Company are due shortly and the financial position of the Company will not allow of all these surveys being carried out simultaneously.

The Company are in the hands of the Bank and are making a strong effort to pay their way.

In the circumstances, the "WYRE LAW" will have to be withdrawn from class, or perhaps a further postponement could be agreed to, provided a commencement of the survey was carried out. This would mean a total extension of about 12 months past the due date before it was completed.


The vessel is in an efficient state and the Owners' proposal is submitted for consideration.
