Deutsche Werft A.G. attend their works at Hamburg-Finkenwärder on the 12th November, 1931, and subsequent dates for the purpose of testing and examining two Superheaters of about 68.8 m² heating surface each to the order of Messrs. A. Borsig G.m.b.H. of Berlin-Tegel and intended for Messrs. Naskov Skibsværft's No. 51.

These Superheaters have been built in accordance with the approved plan, the materials used in the construction have been tested by the Society's Surveyors and the workmanship is satisfactory. When finished they have been submitted to hydraulic pressure of 70.- kgs. per sq.cm. and were found sound and tight when under pressure.
