With reference to my letters of the 29th April and 18th May last, to which I do not appear to have been favoured with a reply, respecting your steam trawler "CLAIRE JANINE", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have again had the case of this vessel before them at their Meeting to-day, and that in view of the intimation contained in your letter of the 20th April instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
