Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 22nd ultimo respecting the steamer "CHIPPEWA", and note that she is at present laid up for the winter months.

With reference to your conclusion that it will not be necessary to examine the oil fuel installation under working conditions as the oil burners have been removed, I have to say that as the oil fuel installation can be used at any time by replacing the oil burners, it should be examined and reported to be in good condition.

If, however, it is not intended to use it at present, no good purpose can be served by its examination now under working conditions.

I may add that it is the Committee's practice to retain in the Society's Register Book the record of "Fitted for oil fuel" until the oil fuel fittings and pumps have been removed from the vessel's stokehold.
