undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Robert Warner & Co Ltd (Engineers), attend at their at Walten-on-the-Naze on the 17th January 1919 and submit dates for the purpose of examining during construction, an Anthony Type General Service Pump, 7"x 8"x12", designated 10 and intended for Messrs Richardson, Westgarth & Co. Ltd their S.S. No 1.

Several parts have been examined for workmanship and material found satisfactory, afterwards tested by hydraulic pressure follows:-

Cylinder 400lbs per square inch.

Cylinder 200lbs per square inch.

Action and discharge valves and boxes to 200lbs per square inch and all found tight and sound.

When being erected, the pump was tried under working conditions quantity and running tests and proved satisfactory.
