This vessel is in such a condition as will satisfy the Swedish Authorities that their requirements for existing ships have been complied with.

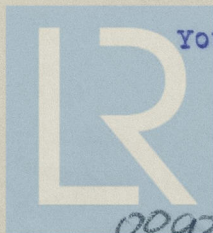

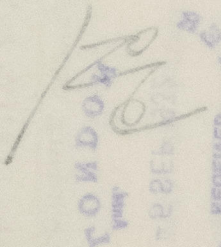
