Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your cablegram of the 25th ultimo, respecting the case of the steamer "BULLAREN", and with regard thereto I have to confirm the following cablegram despatched to you today, namely:-

"BULLAREN WASVAWAUSK (= the freeboard assigned is "10'-9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from top of statutory deck line to centre of disc) WAVYRWEUCUC (= the statutory deck line is 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " above the steel deck at side; the other lines should be marked as follows: Fresh Water 7" above centre of disc) WEDNIWEERV (Indian Summer 6" above centre of disc, Winter 6" below centre of Disc) WHURT (compulsory freeboard) WHEN REQUIREMENTS CLOSING TONNAGE OPENING "VEJYF (complied with)".

I now enclose herewith two copies of a memorandum setting forth the freeboards which have been assigned to this vessel.
