## ANSWER.

Date:— 21st March, 1949.

This vessel is still laid up at Trincomalee but I understand from the Ceylon Government Surveyor that he was recently asked to hold a survey with a view to issuing a Certificate to allow the vessel to be towed to India. He has informed the Owners that in his opinion the vessel is only fit for scrap and that considerable repairs would need carrying out before he would issue a Certificate even for a blind tow.
