

winches and when proceeding from one part of the Canal to another is always attended by a tug.

"I shall be glad if you will inform me if you will be prepared to carry out this inspection when the craft is next in dock.

"For your information I would inform you that since the arrival of this dredger in the Manchester Ship Canal in 1924 the engines have only been used for the propulsion of the vessel on two occasions and then only for a period of approximately a total of 4/5 hours."
