I suppose if the owner let another anchor <sup>car 2</sup> 6-1-10 with one of the present and board of  $\frac{5 \cdot 0 \cdot 18}{11 \cdot 2 \cdot 0}$  making the two <sup>car 2</sup> 11-2-0 of which will be sufficient.
