Dear Sir,

Reverting to my letter of the 24th ultimo, respecting the classification in the Society's Register Book of your motor vessel "DIOLINDA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had before them a communication received from the Society's Surveyor at Dublin from which it appears you have informed him that it is not your desire to maintain the vessel's classification with this Society, and I am directed to say that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
