This vessel became due for Second Special Survey No. 1
in November last and for survey of the screw shaft in August
last.

In a letter, dated 6th instant, the Society's
Surveyor at Dublin states he is informed by the Owner that
it is not intended to maintain the vessel's classification
in the Society's Register Book and that application has been
made to the Irish Free State Authorities for a loadline
certificate.

The case received the consideration of the Classing
Committee on Tuesday, 13th instant, when it was decided to give
instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from
the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof,
indicating withdrawal of class at Owner's request.
