NAGASAKI WORKS, MITSUBISHI JUKÖGYÖ KABUSHIKI KAISHA. for Messrs. Nippon Yusen Kabushiki Kaisha of 6,500 Tons. Length 140 metres Breadth 19 metres, Depth 12.3 metres intended to be Classed 100A1, LMC

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
