With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the Motor Ferries "DELFINA MITRE" and "DOLORES DE URQUIZA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had under consideration a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Buenos Ayres, from which it appears they have been informed by your goodself that it is not the intention of your Board to maintain these vessels in the Society's classification, and I have to say that, in the circumstances, the Committee have now given instructions for the vessels' classes to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I should add that in view of the withdrawal of these vessels' classes, the records of the freeboards assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
