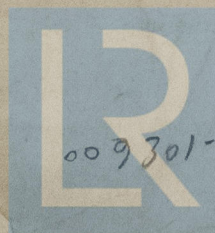
The survey of the screw shaft of this tug became due in September last.

The vessel has recently been sold to the Southern Railway Company, and in a letter, dated 26th ultimo, the Divisional Marine Manager & Harbour Master, Newhaven, states that it has been decided not to continue the classification of the vessel in the Society's Register Book.

In the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Friday, 4th instant, decided to give instructions for the character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
