Motorship "RYAD"

Further to my letter of the 7th August, I would acquaint you that we have now been informed by the Suez Surveyor that the ship has sailed from that port and that the Donkey Boiler and Tailshaft Surveys have not been held. The Suez Surveyor also states that he was verbally informed that after loading at Suez the ship was bound for Hong Kong for breaking up.

In view of the fact that the Committee's previous decision was not complied with, this case has been again submitted to the Committee to-day, who have given instructions for a notation to be recorded in the Register Book indicating that the class of the ship has been expunged on account of non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
